1. The games take place according to the rules of the FIFA and the Vorarlberg football federation.
2. The games are umpired by official referees.
3. The age of the players is being verified before the start of the tournament. The players must be in possession of a valid photo document for identification.
4. Each team is obligated to bring along a second set of outfits of another colour. If the club colours differ too little before the beginning of the game, the team, which is mentioned first, must change the outfits.
5. Football boots with cleats are explicitly permitted only in the categories U-17 and U-15.
6. If a team should arrive too late to the game (without excusable reason), the punishment amounts automatically 3:0 for the opponent.
7. If teams within a group are tied, the following applies: 1. goal ratio, 2. gained goal scores, 3. direct match results, 4. Lot decision
8. If a playoff game ends in a tie, a penalty shootout takes place, all players noted in the game report may shoot! The penalty shootout will start immediately after the game beside the main field.
9. If a final game ends in a tie, a penalty shootout takes place.
10. If something is not covered by the tournament rules, the tournament arbitration decides.
11. A player is entitled to play in only one team during the entire tournament.
12. Only written protests in German or English language are being accepted.
13. The official tournament language is German. In case of possible wrong interpretations in the translations of the tournament regulation, the version in German language applies.
14. The tournament organiser and the "Eurosporting" do not assume liability for damage and loss of the property of the participants or for personal injuries.
